## RHE Parent Consultation

I am writing to update you on the RHE (Relationships and Health Education) parent consultation process.

As a Local Authority (LA) maintained school, we have been followed the LA suggested consultation timeline in spring term. We adapted the LA materials for Barley Lane Primary School. Our own school-based consultation began on the 14th of May when parents were able to comment on our draft policy and syllabus using an online feedback form. Thank you for sharing your feedback. Your comments and questions were very useful. Feedback was collated and some amendments were made to the syllabus to address some of the concerns raised and feel it is more suited to our local community.

This week there have been opportunities for parents to come into school to view resources that will be used with the children from September and to raise questions with members of the Senior Leadership Team. Yesterday's discussions were very fruitful and we there are some further areas for us to consider. Today, we will be available between 9:30 - 11:30 and 1:45 - 3:45 via the main entrance.
