

Guidance for Reopening Summer 2020

Walking to school can be fun, but we need to stay safe!

- Only one family member must walk with you, to keep us all safe, and we must not stay to chat.
- You can come to school at your allocated drop off time and entrance, and you must line up for your bubble.
- Social distancing measures are strictly in place. There are markings on the playground for you to follow.



One-way system

- To keep us all safe and to ensure we maintain social distancing, we have a one-way system now in place on our stairs and in our corridors.
- You must follow the signs and travel throughout the school in this direction only.

Uniform

- You must wear a freshly washed uniform every day to ensure everyone's safety.
- Once you arrive home, you must change your clothes and wash your hands, to protect your family.
- You may be asked to wear a clean PE kit to school on the day of a PE lesson.
- Lockers will not be in use; you must keep all your belongings with you at your allocated desk.



Our curriculum

- School and home learning will be mirrored, and we will all be following the same curriculum.
- There will be a series of PSHE lessons to support our emotional health and wellbeing. Resources for this can also be accessed via the school website.
- Teachers will be giving verbal feedback on your work.

Lunch



- You have the option of bringing in a packed lunch from home or ordering a packed lunch from the school kitchen. No hot meals will be available at this time.
- We will be eating our packed lunches in our bubble classroom, maintaining social distancing measures.

Bubbles

- All bubbles have been allocated an animal name.
- There will be up to 9 children in each bubble. Both staff and pupils will not be mixing between these bubbles.
- A resource pack will be made available for each of you. These must not be shared.
- To keep us all safe, it is very important we do not bring any items from home into school, except for your packed lunch, a water bottle and a sunhat.

Home Time



- School will finish earlier than usual. You must leave promptly via the Barley Lane gates.
- You must go straight home, maintaining social distancing measures.
- Be aware whilst walking home, for your own safety.
- When your parents are meeting you, they must adhere to social distancing measures whilst waiting in the playground.

What to do if you have symptoms:

- If you or anyone at home has symptoms, you must stay home and notify the school immediately.
- If you become unwell at school, tell a member of staff immediately.
- You will be looked after separately, your parents will be informed and will need to collect you urgently.

Staying safe

- On arrival to school, you will all be required to use hand sanitisers that have been installed outside every classroom.
- You will be required to wash your hands regularly throughout the day. Maintaining this at home is important too.
- Play and lunch times will be staggered for each bubble. You must not mix across bubbles. Social distancing is just as vital at these times.
